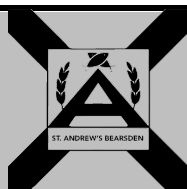

Tea is served in the hut after daily Mass Monday to Thursday. All most welcome.

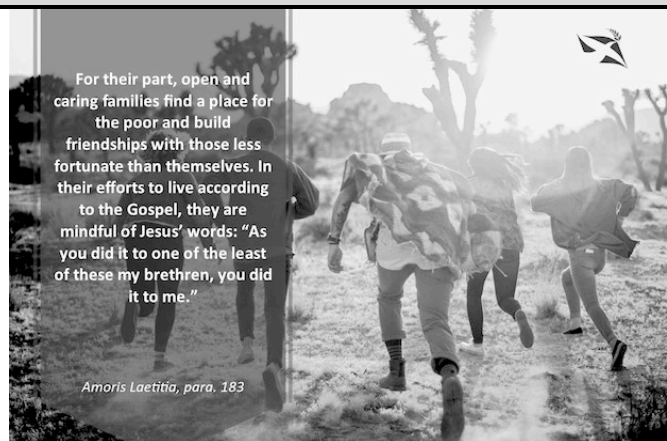
Before receiving Holy Communion, we are asked to make some act of reverence such as a bow.
